





#### **SPECIAL NOTES**

- 1. It must be strictly observed that warming up is not allowed on the actual course. Disciplinary action may be taken against anyone who disregards this.
- 2. Spikes and cross-country shoes must be removed before entering Linwood Sports Centre.
- 3. All Female Races numbers have a YELLOW BAND.
- 4. In all races numbers must be worn on the FRONT. Competitors in the Under 17 and Under 20 Womens Race will wear an age code number on the BACK as well.
- 5. Entries for team events must show the colours of the Club's vest and a vest of these colours must be worn by all members of the team while competing.
- 6. Athletes and spectators must not encroach on the start/finish area.
- 7. I.A.A.F. advertising rules will be strictly enforced.
- 8. At last year's national Cross Country Championships there was unacceptable damage to property and anti social behaviour. Clubs and team managers are requested to ensure that their athletes behave in a responsible manner in Linwood Sports Centre and there is no damage to equipment or facilities. Suitable adult supervision should be provided for young athletes by the Clubs at all times. Young athletes are encouraged to make use of the organised multi sport activities.
- 9. Computer results will be on sale on the day.

#### The AT Mays Trophy for the overall Team performance

#### Rules determining Winner of Trophy

- a) Clubs will be awarded points in each race equal to the finish position of their team 1st team (1 point), 2nd team (2 points), etc.
- b) The AT Mays Trophy will be awarded to the club that scores the lowest aggregate number of points over the five national championships (calculated as above)
- c) If part b fails to obtain a result then only clubs that have finished a senior team and declared teams in all other races are eligible for this trophy. In this case the trophy will be awarded to the club with the lowest aggregate number of points calculated as follows:
  - for finishing team points are awarded as "a" above
  - For declared but non-finishing teams the points awarded will be the highest team placing plus 1.

The result will be determined for clubs with 4 finishing teams and if failing to achieve a result, for 3 finishing teams and then 2 finishing teams.

- d) Clubs not finishing a senior team are not eligible for this trophy.
- e) In all cases in the event of a tie the position of the club finishing highest in the Senior race will be adjudged the winner

The Pat Spence Memorial Trophy will be awarded for the overall women's team performance.




