National Cross Country Championships Falkirk FK1 1SY (Callendar Park) SATURDAY 23rd February 2013

PARKING

Parking is at Graeme High School with overflow parking at the business centre at the east end of Callender Park and at the west end of Callender park (see course map) **Do not park near the high flats, parking there is for residents only. If it is at all possible please car share.**

DECLARATIONS

Open 9.30am in the Foyer Area of Graeme High School (First Race 11.30am) **Team Managers should collect Team Envelopes containing individual envelopes for each athlete**.

CHIPS

There is a separate envelope for each athlete containing Timing chip, tie cords, instruction on how to attach chip to laces and athlete's number.

Chips not used must be returned to declarations before the end of the afternoon.

Chips not used or returned to declarations will be charged to clubs at £8.00 per chip.

A full manual recording system will also operate as previous years, after crossing the timing mats at the finish gantry athletes will be directed info funnels and will be manually recorded before entering the de-chipping area.

UNDER 17 WOMEN /UNDER 20 WOMEN

Under 17 Women and Under 20 Women run together. Under 17 have YELLOW numbers, Under 20 have RED numbers, both these age groups wear numbers on the FRONT and BACK.

CHANGING

In Graeme High School. Males in the Main Hall. Females in the Female Changing Rooms **Strictly no spikes or racing shoes should be worn in the school.**

Scottish National Cross Country Championships Falkirk (Callender Park) SATURDAY 23rd February 2013

General directions for all:- Follow Brown road Signs for Callendar Park and House

From Edinburgh and Forth Road Bridge:-

Take M9 to junction 5 (you should see above signs from here)

At end of slip road take 1st exit on to A9. Follow this for approx 1.5 miles going straight over the first roundabout, you will see the football stadium in front on your right.

At next roundabout turn left (1st exit) and go uphill for approx 500 metres until next roundabout.

Take 3rd exit (turn right) and go under railway bridge. You will see Graeme High School, but at next roundabout turn left and then first right for parking.

From Glasgow, Stirling and Kincardine Bridge:-

Take M9 to junction 6 (you should see above signs from here)

At end of slip road turn right and after approx half a mile you will reach a roundabout.

Take 3rd exit sign posted Falkirk and go up and over the railway line. You will see football stadium on your left.

At roundabout beside stadium turn left (1st exit) and past by stadium and fire station and go under railway bridge until you reach next roundabout.

Take 2nd exit (bearing right) and go up the hill for approx 500 metres.

At next roundabout turn right (3rd exit) and go under railway bridge.

You will see Graeme high School, but at mini roundabout turn left and then first right for parking.

Alternative parking is within the park at the West End. Stay on Callendar Road past Graeme High School, (you will see the course on your left) and straight over two mini roundabouts before a big roundabout. At this roundabout take the first exit to turn left into Callendar Park. Go up the hill and <u>straight on</u> the car park is on your right adjacent to the golf course.
