#### **Important Notes**

- (1) Location map and additional information will be shown on the scottishathletics website www.scottishathletics.org.uk
- (2) Team scoring for all Races is 6 to count.
- (3) All selected athletes must be members of scottishathletics at the time of the event. Athletes with an out of date membership cannot be added after the selection date.
- (4) A selected athlete MUST not be substituted by a non-selected athlete at any time.

Non observance of the above leaves the whole field and the officials uninsured in the event of an accident; leaves the athlete at a health risk in the case of a wrong identification of the athlete; and makes the results invalid as an historic record.

- (5) By accepting selection all athletes agree that photographs and/or video footage may be taken and used for PR/Marketing purposes.
- (6) Athletes agree that they are medically fit to compete, have no medical issues or disability that would endanger themselves or others by taking part (and will not run if unfit to do so on the day).
- (7) Any athlete with Additional Support Needs should contact scottishathletics for an athlete assistance form.

# EAST DISTRICT CROSS COUNTRY SELECTION POLICY 2021/22

This document aims to ensure that the selection process is clear and transparent to everyone.

There are two occasions when teams are selected to represent the East District in Cross Country Competitions: -

### Inter Districts Cross Country (Incorporated into UK CC Challenge) - Stirling

Event Date 15 Jan 2022

Selection Date 6 Dec 2021

Teams SEN/ U17/ U15/ U13

District teams are up to 15 to run with 6 to score.

Selection for U13, U15, U17, Senior/Junior Male & Females will be 1st 10 from East District Cross Country Championships at Stirling on Saturday 4th December plus up to 5 others on all known form with weighting to Stirling.

**Selection Notes** 

The Senior Teams may include some U20 athletes. The U20's and Seniors compete in separate races of different distances at the East District Championships which makes head-to-head comparisons difficult.

The Selectors therefore have to make a judgement as to which U20's might be considered for the Senior Team.

## **Inter Counties Cross Country - Loughborough**

Event Date 12 March 22

Selection Date 28 Feb 2022

Teams SEN / U20 / U17

Athlete Cont. £30

Selection will be made largely on results from the National Cross Country Championships at Falkirk on Saturday 26th February 2022.

Entries for this race must be made by the end of January 2022, therefore entries are submitted before the final selection race. Senior Athletes should keep selectors informed of their availability for this competition.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:-**

If an athletes name appears on the start list this DOES NOT guarantee that they will be selected for the final East District Team.

The East District do not select U13 athletes for this competition. Only U13 athletes who have competed in earlier UK Cross Country Challenge meetings are able to enter and compete, making their own arrangements for travel and accommodation to this competition.
